## COVER FLOW



→ Generates a slideshow based on a picture folder.

### ➤ Effect Parameters

#### **Images Sources**

Click on this button to select the pictures that will be used in the slideshow. Once the selection is completed a new window opens. It permits to change the picture's order of appearance and their title.

#### **Presets**

Presets contain a snapshot of the plug-in parameters. The Presets control lets you choose among one of the presets built into the plug-in, save current parameter values to a preset file, or load an existing preset file from disk. A preset file saved to disk via the "Save As" button can be loaded from another instance of the same plug-in by clicking the "Open" button. Presets generated in one host can also be loaded from the same plug-in when used in a different host.

### ➤ Timing

#### **Pre-Roll**

Pre-roll duration before the beginning of the animation.

## **ImageDuration**

The duration of each media.

## **Transition Duration**

The duration of each transition between media.

### ➤ Media

#### **Size**

The size of each media.

#### **X offset**

The gap between each media in the background.

#### **Z offset**

The distance of the media in the background.

#### **Angle**

The angle of the media in the background.

### ➤ Media Title

The titles are displayed centered in a safe frame. You can set the size and the position of this frame with coordinates relative to the screen.

#### **Enable**

Display or hide the media title.

#### **Width**

The width of the title safe frame.

#### **Height**

The height of the title safe frame.

#### **X Position**

The X position of the title safe frame.

#### **Y Position**

The Y position of the title safe frame.

**Font**

The font of the title.

**Font Size**

The font size of the title.

**Color**

The color of the title.

**Inner Shadow**

The intensity of the inner shadow.

➤ **Background**

**Use Horizon**

Display or hide the horizon.

**Gradient Colors**

The gradient colors used as background.
